REFLECTION QUESTIONS

HEAD: Questions aimed at our minds to help us *understand* God's word.

- What do you know about Genesis? What themes and/or questions come to mind when you think about the book?
- Read Genesis 1:1, and then verses 26 What important truths does this verse communicate to us about God and his creation?
- Read Genesis 1:31 What important truths does this verse communicate to us about God and his creation?

HEART: Questions aimed at our affections to help us *love* God

- How do the scriptures you just read communicate to us that God is a loving God?
- Read Genesis 3:1-7 How is the goodness of God marred here?
- Jesus says of the Old Testament, including Genesis "You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me." In what ways do the verses listed above point us to Jesus and the Gospel?

HANDS: Questions aimed at our hands to help us *live for* God (Personally, Communally, and Missionally).

- In what ways are you tempted to turn away from God's goodness toward the false promises of sin?
- In what ways do the scriptures you've reflected on above lead to worship God?
- How can you make the most of our Sermon Series through Genesis? What are some practical ways you can dive deeper into study?
